



## What is the Digital Library?

- Provide feedback on posting process, Quality Criteria, and usability of software


## State Network of Educators (SNE)

- Submit and review resources using Quality Criteria
- Use resources and collaboration tools for own professional learning and instruction
- Provide feedback on the resources in the library, the review and posting processes the Quality Criteria, and the usability of the Library
