



**ACCESS for ELLs 2.0** is a secure large-scale English language proficiency assessment administered to Kindergarten through 12th grade students who have been identified as English language learners (ELLs). It is given annually to monitor students' progress in acquiring academic English.

Training to give the assessment is available online at [WIDA.us](http://WIDA.us). Beyond training, the only requirement to give the ACCESS 2.0 is that the test administrator must be a district employee that, at a minimum, meets the [requirements of a paraprofessional](#).

Students required to take the ACCESS assessment are: Those K-12 students that are identified for ESL services (LEP\_RCV and LEP\_NRC in Core Data) **AND** Enrolled in a Missouri public school or charter school. Students in Monitored status **DO NOT** take the ACCESS test.
