

Students are already tired after school , That's to much school for a student because they can't learn things if they are tired, if thier tired then they won't want to pay attention to what's going on at school or what they're learning about

Organization/Purpose – 1

- Too brief (2 “sentences”) to provide a discernible structure
- Claim is present “too tired”
- No transitions

Evidence/Elaboration – 1

- Evidence is minimal “they won't want to pay attention...”

Conventions – 0

- Severity—missing capitalized letters, ending punctuation and spelling errors
- Density—multiple errors in the 2 sentences written
