

Missouri Collegiate DECA Member of the Year

This award honors Collegiate DECA members who have made outstanding contributions to the association at the local and state levels. Each local chapter is eligible to submit one nominee. The nominee must attend the State Career Development Conference in order to receive recognition.

Nomination Procedures

1. A letter (2-page maximum) outlining the member's participation in Collegiate DECA
2. A letter of recommendation from the local chapter advisor should be sent to the state office with the State CDC registration materials.
3. Participate in a brief interview at the State CDC.

Criteria

1. Submitted 2 page letter and letter of recommendation from Chapter Advisor.
2. Participated in a project with business and industry as a planned chapter function.
3. Participated in a project to benefit a civic/community organization.
4. Organized a major chapter function.
5. Served as a local or state officer or a committee chair.
6. Attended a Collegiate DECA state or national conference or participated in assisting with a high school DECA function.
7. Represented Collegiate DECA before a civic, professional, or school group.

Judging

The judge considers the above criteria and the interview in the selection of the Missouri Collegiate DECA Member of the Year. A plaque is presented to the winner. The runners up will be recognized with certificates. Recognition will take place at the Awards Session of the State CDC.
