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## Introduction to Career Education Placement Data

This data packet is prepared annually and contains primary and summary data regarding the placement of graduating<sup>1</sup>/ completing<sup>2</sup> students of career education programs. The primary source of data is the Missouri Student Information System (MOSIS) of the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education.

The summary of career education placement data provides information regarding each fiscal year's placement data; contains data coverage definition; and significant findings, changes, and trends for placement rates.

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<sup>1</sup> Secondary students graduating from high school and completing at least one career education program, in some cases it is only a course, during their high school career.


<sup>2</sup> Postsecondary and adult students completing at least one career education program. Adult data includes only those students who have received 500+ hours of instruction.

### 5-Year Placement Rates by Level





### 5-Year Related Placement Rates by Level





2012 Secondary Agriculture Education Placement Data for Secondary Graduates




Secondary Agriculture Education Placement Data for Secondary Graduates (5-Year Average)









2012 Secondary Cooperative Occupational Education Placement Data for Secondary Graduates




Secondary Cooperative Occupational Education Placement Data for Secondary Graduates (5-Year Average)













Secondary Skilled Technical Sciences Placement Data for Secondary Graduates (5-Year Average)






