WHAT IS THE PURPOSE?

The purpose of the Career Preparation Certificate Program is to promote the development of necessary knowledge, skills, and attitudes for Missouri's high school seniors to have successful and productive careers. This voluntary program is designed for high schools to develop and endorse a certificate for students who meet certain standards that demonstrate that the students are "ready to work."

HOW DOES THE PROGRAM WORK?

Participating school districts partner with employers to determine the program requirements and documentation. In developing the program, schools can be equipped to better match individual knowledge and skills to occupational expectations in the local area or across

the state. To sustain the program, communities are encouraged to ensure that it is "demand-driven" by employers. Employers that participate in the program can benefit from improved job placement and satisfaction, resulting in increased productivity and decreased turnover.

What are the expected criteria for a Career Prep Certificate?

The **academic components** of the program are cross-referenced with Missouri's "Show-Me" Standards and Grade-Level Expectations.

- Applied Math
- Reading Comprehension
- Communication: Verbal, Written, Listening
- Critical Thinking and Problem Solving
- Information Technology
- Gather/Evaluate Information

The **work readiness components** are aligned with Missouri's Career Development Standards and Grade-Level Expectations.

- Professional and Ethical Behavior
- Personal Accountability
- Interpersonal Skills
- Self-direction and Self-management
- Lifelong Learning
