

## **Missouri HOSA 2019 State Leadership Conference**

### **Recognition Event Guidelines and Deadlines**

- **Barbara James Service Award** (Refer to [http://www.hosa.org/sites/default/files/18-19%20BJSA%20Final\\_0.pdf](http://www.hosa.org/sites/default/files/18-19%20BJSA%20Final_0.pdf) for Guidelines)
  - The State Leadership Conference deadline is **February 15, 2019**. Activities must be entered and **APPROVED by local chapter advisors** in the online HOSA Activity Tracking System by midnight of the deadline date.
  - Hours are pro-rated to 75 hours for SLC recognition. If a member has exceeded the 100 hours for ILC recognition, the Bronze/Silver/Gold award will be granted according to the guidelines. **Awards will be given as follows at the SLC:**
    - **75.0 – 99.9 Approved Hours = State Recognition Certificate**
    - **100.0 – 174.9 Approved Hours = Bronze National Level Recognition**
    - **175.0 – 249.9 Approved Hours = Silver National Level Recognition**
    - **250.0+ Approved Hours = Gold National Level Recognition**
  
- **HOSA Happenings** (Refer to <http://www.hosa.org/sites/default/files/18-19%20NL%20final.pdf> for Guidelines)
  - Submissions for this award must include one print copy of the original newsletter (minimum of 4 pages and maximum of 8 pages) OR a printed version of the chapter website home page and other pages (minimum of 4 pages and maximum of 8 pages), AND the cover page found on page 5 of the guidelines, and must be received by March 25, 2019 at the SLC. **Please bring the submission to the HOSA Help Desk no later than 5:30 pm on Monday, March 25, 2019.**
  - **Submissions that earn 80 points or higher will be recognized at the state level.**
  - This event is not judged at the National level. All newsletters and websites earning a score of 80 points or higher at the state level will be eligible for recognition at the HOSA International Leadership Conference. The names of those chapters who earn 80 points or higher will be submitted to National HOSA by the State Advisor.
  - STEM Premier will **not** be utilized at the Missouri HOSA 2019 State Leadership Conference. A print submission must be received.

- **Healthcare Issues Exam** (Refer to <http://www.hosa.org/sites/default/files/18-19%20HCIE%20Final%20Nov6.pdf> for Guidelines)
  - Each state will be allowed to enter any qualified HOSA member, based on a formula set by the national office. **All students attending the SLC are eligible to take the exam, but must register for this event.**
  - The State test will cover information from July 1<sup>st</sup> – November 1<sup>st</sup>. Dates for ILC testing will be from January 1<sup>st</sup> – May 15<sup>th</sup>.
  - **At the SLC, the top 10% will be recognized by reading a list of those names. The top scorer will receive special recognition and a certificate.**

  - **2018-2020 Service Organization: National Pediatric Cancer Foundation** (<https://nationalpcf.org/hosa/>)
  - Donations and volunteer hours will be tracked by the local chapter advisor. Donations should be noted on just ONE chapter member's account. (For example, if each member of chapter participated, but money was also raised, EVERY member can track the volunteer hours, but only ONE member will track the donation.)
  - **For State recognition, this event may include activities from June 1, 2018-February 15, 2019.**
  - **State Certificates of Recognition** will be awarded to all chapters who contribute a **minimum of \$75.00 and/or 75 hours of community service** in partnership with the organization.
  - **State Certificates of Merit** will be awarded to all chapters who contribute a minimum of **\$375.00 and/or 375 hours of community service** in partnership with the organization.
  
- **Outstanding HOSA Achievement** (Refer to <http://www.hosa.org/sites/default/files/18-19%20OA%20Final.pdf> for Guidelines)
  - This event is designed to recognize chartered associations for their special achievements, projects, events, and activities that are completed by and unique to individual chartered associations.

- To be eligible for this event, chartered associations of HOSA-Future Health Professionals must be in good standing. Each local chapter can submit one entry. In order to determine the ONE state entry submitted, any chapter wishing to apply for this achievement must submit their chapter's entry to the State Advisor by **March 1, 2019** via email to [Shelly.Wehmeyer@dese.mo.gov](mailto:Shelly.Wehmeyer@dese.mo.gov).
- All entries will be considered and scored by a committee determined by the State Advisor, and the highest scoring entry based on the Rating Sheet will be submitted for International recognition.
  
- **Outstanding HOSA Chapter Middle School** (*Refer to <http://www.hosa.org/sites/default/files/18-19%20OHCMiddleSchool%20Final.pdf> for Guidelines*)
  - **The reflection book is limited to one entry per chapter and must be turned in to the HOSA Help Desk no later than 5:30 pm on Monday, March 25, 2019.**
  - At the State Leadership Conference, one chapter member will bring the reflection book to the HOSA Help Desk. Dress points will not be awarded to any chapter for the State Leadership Conference submission. **Competitors can collect their reflection book from the HOSA Help Desk on Tuesday, March 26, 2019 between the hours of 1:00-3:00 pm. Missouri HOSA does not take responsibility for any reflection books remaining after 3:00 pm that were not collected by the chapter.**
  - All entries must be submitted in an official Outstanding HOSA Chapter book and pages from Awards Unlimited.
  - The reflection book will contain materials from July 1 through the State Leadership Conference.
  - **All reflection books that earn 24 points at the State Leadership Conference will be recognized with a chapter certificate and be eligible to enter the International Leadership Conference.**
  - Each chapter should only register ONE member for the Outstanding HOSA Chapter event. The CHAPTER name will be announced at the State Leadership Conference if the book qualifies for recognition.
  
- **Outstanding HOSA Chapter Secondary and Postsecondary/Collegiate** (*Refer to <http://www.hosa.org/sites/default/files/18-19%20OHC%20PSC-SS%20Final.pdf> for Guidelines*)

- **The reflection book is limited to one entry per chapter and must be turned in to the HOSA Help Desk no later than 5:30 pm on Monday, March 25, 2019.**
  - At the State Leadership Conference, one chapter member will bring the reflection book to the HOSA Help Desk. Dress points will not be awarded to any chapter for the State Leadership Conference submission. **Competitors can collect their reflection book from the HOSA Help Desk on Tuesday, March 26, 2019 between the hours of 1:00-3:00 pm. Missouri HOSA does not take responsibility for any reflection books remaining after 3:00 pm that were not collected by the chapter.**
  - All entries must be submitted in an official Outstanding HOSA Chapter book and pages from Awards Unlimited.
  - The reflection book will contain materials from July 1 through the State Leadership Conference.
  - **All reflection books that earn 38 points at the State Leadership Conference will be recognized with a chapter certificate and be eligible to enter the International Leadership Conference.**
  - Each chapter should only register ONE member for the Outstanding HOSA Chapter event. The CHAPTER name will be announced at the State Leadership Conference if the book qualifies for recognition.
- **MRC Volunteer Recognition** (Refer to [http://www.hosa.org/sites/default/files/MV18-19Final\\_0.pdf](http://www.hosa.org/sites/default/files/MV18-19Final_0.pdf) for Guidelines)
    - **For state recognition, this event may include activities from June 1, 2018 – March 1, 2019.** Activities must be entered and **APPROVED** by chapter advisors in the online HOSA Activity Tracking System **by midnight of March 1, 2019.** The number of approved hours in the system is what will be used to identify recognition levels at the State Leadership Conference.
    - **Certificates will be awarded to all individual HOSA members who complete a minimum of thirty (30) hours of service between June 1, 2018 and March 1, 2019.**
    - **Members who receive recognition will be recognized with a certificate at the State Leadership Conference.**
