Please ask your student interviewees at least 5 or 6 of the questions listed below, and then feel welcome to ask them any other questions that you want.

1. Tell me about yourself.
2. Describe the accomplishment of which you are most proud.
3. What strengths could you bring to this position?
4. What are your career and educational goals?
5. Tell me about the skills you gained through your “training” program.
6. What would you like to be doing five/ten years from now?
7. Why are you pursuing this field?
8. What is your greatest weakness?
9. What has been your greatest challenge?
10. Give me a specific example of a time when a coworker or classmate criticized your work in front of others. How did you respond?
11. Tell me about what you learned from your previous jobs.
12. Do you have any questions?
