- Science student reports available 10 days following district assessment window

January 11 – March 18

- Monitor students' acquisition of academic English in the domains of speaking, listening, reading, and writing
- INSIGHT platform
- Reports to districts April 29

# ACT

April 19 – May 3 (Online)

April 19 – May 3 (Accommodated paper and pencil)

April 19 (Paper and pencil)

May 3 (Make-up paper and pencil)

- 11<sup>th</sup> grade census administration
- ACT accommodations available in both formats
- Student reports mailed 3-8 weeks after testing
- School reports and score labels arrive 3-8 weeks after testing
- District profile by September 2

# Personal Finance

October 5 – January 27

February 22 – May 27

June 6 – August 26

- Missouri Personal Finance Competencies
- Online platform
- Required for students taking a course in which Personal Finance competencies are embedded
- Required for students who are attempting to demonstrate mastery or “test out”
