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Tentative Timeline:

- CCR ID Cleanup – July 27, 2016 to Aug. 5, 2016
- Appeal Window – Sept. 6, 2016 to Sept. 23, 2016
- Data Freeze to generate Preliminary 2016 APR – Sept. 23, 2016
- Preliminary APR – Oct. 3, 2016
- Data Freeze to generate Final 2016 APR – Oct. 21, 2016
- Final APR available behind secure login – Oct. 31, 2016
- Embargoed data available to press – Nov. 2, 2016
- APR available to public – Nov. 7, 2016



Federal Accountability

- Transition to Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) will begin during the 2017-18 school year

The MCDS is a new resource provided by the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education that allows school personnel and the public to access education-related data.

The data made available to the public masks or hides data for groups with 10 or fewer students to protect confidential information about individual students, as required by federal law. The MCDS is still in development. In the coming months, a secured area of the website will become available to authorized school personnel to access unmasked school district and school building data.

- Guided Inquiry for summary reports allowing simple filters.

In addition to accountability . . .

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- Federal Programs:
 - Title I, II, III, Homeless
 - 3 year monitoring cycle
- Extended Learning Grant funding available
 - Next application window (month)
- MoVIP
 - *Medically fragile students*



Federal Programs

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- Tiered Monitoring Process includes:
 - Desk Reviews – Yearly
 - Desk Monitoring – Cohort
 - Self Monitoring Checklist – 4 components submitted quarterly
 - Due by 15th of the month: October, December, February and April
 - Documentation uploads are required
 - Desk Reviews – Yearly
 - On-Site Reviews – Year immediately following Desk Monitoring
 - 20% of Cohort
 - Risk-based indicators



Afterschool Programs

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- Provide academic enrichment to complement regular academic programs during non-school hours
- Competitive grant funding available:
 - School Age Community Grant: serving ages 5-13
 - 21st Century Community Learning Center Grant: serving grades K-12

Migrant, English Language Learners

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- Must ask **all** students at enrollment:
 - Is a language other than English spoken at home?
 - Has the student's family crossed district lines in the past 36 months to obtain agriculturally related work?
- Districts must not ask for the SSN of students without explaining the use of that information.

 - Provide day-to-day supervision of PAT program
 - Document services through DESE Compliance Plan and Invoicing
 - Document services through Affiliate Program Report with PATNC



Early Learning Grant Opportunities

- The Missouri Preschool Program (MPP) is a competitive grant opportunity to create or expand high quality early care and education programs for children who are one or two years from kindergarten eligibility.
- The Child Care Development Fund Grant is a competitive opportunity for public schools and colleges/universities. The goal of this funding is to increase early childhood program availability and quality in public schools and colleges/universities in order to provide a safe environment that meets the individual, developmental, social, emotional, and physical needs of children ages 6 weeks to kindergarten entry.
- Opportunities for these grants will be available in the Fall. Check the Early Learning webpage for details.
