- ❑ High School Readiness – Report 8th Grade as Remained Advanced

- Standards and Indicators approved by the Missouri State Board of Education
- Currently in Process of Developing Calculations to be used in APR
 - ❑ MSIP Advisory will assist in review of calculations

- Recruiting
 - ❑ Districts/charters interested in piloting MSIP 6 APR
 - ❑ Districts interested in piloting Continuous Improvement Measures



ESSA Update

- Why: Improve the Lowest Performing *Schools*
- Identify Based on:
 - ❑ Academic achievement
 - ❑ Academic improvement (Elementary and Middle)
 - ❑ Graduation rate (High)
 - ❑ English language acquisition
 - ❑ Attendance
- ❑ **Proposed Changes: Modify the method used for identifying and exiting Comprehensive, Level I Targeted and Level II Targeted Support and Improvement schools**

- Why: Provide funding to improve
 - ❑ Well-rounded education
 - ❑ Learning conditions
 - ❑ Technology-based personalized learning
- How:
 - ❑ Grants to LEAs
 - ❑ State Activity: Access to advanced coursework

- ❑ **Proposed Change: State Activity Focus – School safety, social-emotional, workforce readiness**

- Why: Support Homeless Children and Youth
- How:
 - Grants to Schools with Large Homeless Populations
 - Technical Assistance to All Schools
 - Access to services
 - Removal of barriers
 - Dispute resolution
- **Proposed Changes:**
 - “Stay put” during dispute
 - Complaint need not be in writing
 - “Parent/Guardian, Unaccompanied Youth” instead of “Complainant”

Alternative Methods of Instruction

- Statutory Authority: Section 171.033, RSMo.
 - ❑ Allows for AMI Plan in lieu of make-up day in exceptional or emergency circumstance
 - ❑ Guidance for use with students with disabilities on website
 - ❑ Administrative memo, application and guidance will also be available



MOCAP

- Website Requirements
- Enrollment in MOCAP Courses
 - Course code
 - Must have a course code for every course (especially those students enrolled full-time)
