

FISCAL YEAR 2015 SMALL, RURAL SCHOOL ACHIEVEMENT PROGRAM
AND RURAL LOW-INCOME SCHOOL

Based on information in the 2015-2016 Spreadsheet, following is an overview of the Small Rural School Achievement Program (SRSA) and Rural Low-Income School Program (RLIS) eligibility **changes** from school year 2014-2015 to 2015-2016.

Two districts are eligible for the SRSA Grant in 2015-2016 that were not eligible in 2014-2015:

098-080	Schuyler Co. R-I (ADA less than 600 so moved from RLIS to SRSA)
026-005	Cole Co. R-V (ADA less than 600)

Three districts are not eligible for the SRSA Grant in 2015-2016 that were eligible in 2014-2015 (*Eligible for RLIS):

031-121	Gallatin R-V (ADA greater than 600)*
035-093	Campbell R-II (ADA greater than 600)*
083-001	North Platte Co. R-I (ADA greater than 600)

Five districts are eligible for the Rural Low-Income in 2015-2016 that were not eligible in 2014-2015:

037-037	Gasconade Co. R-II (Census Poverty from 19.02% to 22.74%)
039-142	Fair Grove R-X (Census Poverty from 18.91% to 21%)
061-156	Macon Co. R-I (Census Poverty from 19.92% to 23.3%)

085-045	Laquey R-V (Census Poverty from 17.38% to 20.38%)

Eight districts are not eligible for Rural Low-Income Grant in 2015-2016 that were eligible in 2014-2015:
