

FISCAL YEAR 2018 SMALL, RURAL SCHOOL ACHIEVEMENT PROGRAM AND RURAL LOW-INCOME SCHOOL

Based on information in the 2018-2019 Spreadsheet, following is an overview of the Small Rural School Achievement Program (SRSA) and Rural Low-Income School Program (RLIS) eligibility **changes** from school year 2017-2018 to 2018-2019.

Two districts are not eligible for the SRSA Grant in 2018-2019 that was eligible in 2017-2018 (*Eligible for RLIS):
