The Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act requires State Agencies to certify all Local Education Agencies (LEAs) for compliance with the new meal pattern and therefore eligible to receive the additional 6 cents for every reimbursable lunch served. A memo was sent to all LEAs last week indicating that School Food Services would provide four presentations for assistance in completing the certification documents.
