The following pages contain a series of diagrams that show how the room you identify might be arranged for the assessment.



	Classroom chair


Classroom Style

- Students in rows, facing the same direction
- Good for classrooms



Library or Media Center

- Good for locations where square or round tables are available



Cafeteria

- Good for large rooms with long tables
- If space allows, NAEP staff will put more space between students
