WHAT ARE REALLOCATION FUNDS

2

- Title I funds are allocated on a formula basis.
 - ▣ LEA allotment
 - ▣ School Improvement 1003 funds
 - ▣ SEA Administration

- If the amount granted is more than the LEA or SEA will use, those excess funds are available to LEAs that need additional funds.



TITLE I REALLOCATION CRITERIA

- Section 1126(c) of the ESEA authorizes the SEA to establish the criteria to reallocate excess funds to LEAs.
- Eligible LEAs are those that did not have funds in excess of the carryover limitation in the prior year.
- Since reallocated funds increase the amount of carryover, they are limited to the maximum amount allowed without exceeding the 15% carryover limitation.



REALLOCATION IN JANUARY 2017

- ❑ October 2016: revised allocations cut LEA funding by \$589,048.
- ❑ December 2016: Continuing Resolution (CR) extended to April 28th.
 - ❑ Limited possibility that the CR cut would be restored.
 - ❑ Revised allocations caused overwritten budgets for 268 LEAs. About 200 were for less than \$100.
- ❑ January 2017: In order to minimize time and effort for budget revisions, reallocated funds went to all eligible LEAs.
