

SUMMER SCHOOL QUICK REFERENCE and REMINDERS

- **APPLICATIONS:** The automated *Summer School Application* will be available **March 2, 2020** on Core Data Screen 24A. **Summer school applications are due by June 1, 2020.** There is a submit button on the electronic application to use when completed. Upon review and approval by DESE, a confirmation e-mail will be sent to the designated Summer School Director.
- **NO SCHOOL DAY BREAK REQUIRED BETWEEN REGULAR AND SUMMER SESSIONS:** The requirement for a school day break between regular and summer sessions has been removed.
- **NO AUGUST SUMMER SCHOOL REVIEW CHECKLIST & FINAL APPROVAL FORM:** This form was eliminated in 2017. Related data from the form is now collected digitally in other reporting.
- **MOSIS Due Dates:**
 - The June 2020 Summer Course/Student Assignment file is due through MOSIS by **June 30**.
 - Summer school attendance and membership data are reported in the **August** MOSIS cycle by **August 15**.
- **ASSIGNMENT OF GRADE LEVELS AND BUILDING:**
 - Summer school is considered the beginning of the 2020-2021 school year. All students should be reported in the grade level and building to which they will be assigned in the fall of 2020.
 - **PK:** Only prekindergarten students who turn five by August 1 can be claimed for summer school and ***should be reported as kindergarten students*** per 160.053, RSMo – see [PK Eligibility for State Aid](#).
 - **Kindergarten:** Report children who were in kindergarten during the 2019-20 school year as first graders in the MOSIS June 2020 Summer Course/Student Assignment file.
- **COURSES NOT ALLOWED:** LEAs may **NOT** count the following in their summer school attendance and may not be included as part of an approved summer school program:

Athletic practices	Body conditioning	Weightlifting	Gymnastics
Team sports	Swimming lessons	Cheerleading clinics	Recreation programs
Tuition -based	Study hall	Computer camps	Tennis
Fee-based activities (school or provider)	PE classes w/no credit towards graduation	Band/vocal/instrumental music practices or camps	Community-based, public, Private, non-academic
