Recently, several of you have asked about which APR scores the state will use for accountability purposes for charter schools. After discussion, we've reached the decision that for 1 building charters, you should use the building APR score; and for charters with 2 or more buildings, you should use the LEA APR score.

In addition, many of you are currently working with performance contracts and we would like you to share samples of what you have/will consider when creating those contracts. I am working on a manual for new sponsors and would like to include a "sample performance contract" based on the reality of what you as sponsors are requiring. I think that most of the performance contracts will focus on student academic performance (with an emphasis on the state requirements) and likely will include other measures such as finance, governance, school climate and parental surveys. I'd certainly like to have your input. When I get a draft of the manual would any of you like to critique it for me? Volunteers welcome!

On a note of curiosity, I recently found in another state where the sponsors track school staffing/staffing turnover (administrators, teachers, other staff) and use this as part of their accountability/performance indicators. Are any of you doing/considering that sort of data?
