Standard 2 Subgroup Achievement

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- English language arts, Math and EOC transition for 2015
- Impact of SB1490 – may not lower classification
- Options for Accountability
 - Calculate APR using 2013, 2014 and 2015
 - Calculate APR using 2012, 2013 and 2014
 - Apply scoring guide (page 10) when 3 most recent years of data are not available
 - Use the best
- Growth will continue to be calculated
- Adjust calculation for progress
- 2020 targets will be adjusted for 2015



CCR 3*1-3 ACT

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- Used to measure College and Career Readiness
- Required for all 11th grade students
 - 2015 test date: April 28, 2015
 - Make up date: May 12, 2015
- Best score will be applied to APR (ACT®, SAT®, COMPASS®, ASVAB, WorkKeys®)
- Options for Accountability:
 - Apply LND
 - Deduct .25 for non-participants
 - Negate best score for non-participants



CCR 3*5-6 Placement

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- SB701
 - Students who complete a Department approved career and technical education program will be counted for placement purposes if their placement is not directly related to their training
- The “On Track” and “2020 Target” status targets in the Scoring Guide will be modified
