



CHARTER SCHOOL PROGRAM (CSP) FEDERAL GRANT SUMMARY 2010-2016

Authorized by Title V, part B of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA), the Charter School Program (CSP) competitive grant provides funding to State Education Agencies with the purpose of increasing the national understanding of the charter school model(s) and expanding the number of high-quality charter schools available to students across the nation by providing financial assistance for planning, program design and initial implementation of new charter schools; and to evaluate the effects of charter schools, including their effects on students, student academic achievement.

CSP grant recipients are monitored with the objectives of:

- increasing CSP fiscal and programmatic accountability at the state and local levels;
- supporting and improving grantee capacity in carrying out the purpose of the CSP through timely and efficient administration of federal funds awarded; and
- assisting grantees with planning and implementation of high-quality charter schools.

Following is a chart showing the schools and awards made for all grant years. The number preceding the school name is an indicator of the schools' location. The 115 prefix is for schools in St. Louis, Missouri, and 048 is the prefix for schools in Kansas City, Missouri. Specific information about the awardee can be found on their sponsor's website.
