



## **Missouri School Improvement Program - 5 (MSIP 5) Scoring Guide Work Plan Outline**

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The following steps are recommended for the revision of the Missouri School Improvement Program (MSIP) and development of the MSIP 5 scoring guide. The steps are designed to result in an accountability system that is:

- research based, focusing on actionable indicators shown to differentiate among effective and less effective schools/districts;
- sufficiently reliable for a range of state and federal improvement and accountability purposes; and
- supported by the various constituencies within and beyond the education community.

### **I. Public Input/Regional Advisory Committee**

Purpose: a broad strategy of public meetings and reviews will increase support and result in an accountability system that reflects the principles of constituencies across the state; activities in this step include focus groups designed to determine the indicators that define an effective school/district and review of various potential indicator systems that will establish and measure progress toward achieving Top 10 status. Meeting presentations will be identical and agendas will follow the same format. Presentations, meeting material and written small group feedback will be posted on the department's website at [www.dese.mo.gov/qs/MSIP5.html](http://www.dese.mo.gov/qs/MSIP5.html).

Who: a diverse, well-informed group of school, district and community representatives nominated by education organizations, school districts, higher education institutions and others. Nominees should have experience and expertise that will equip them in providing constructive input reflective of the values of constituencies across the state. Nominees must be available to attend one regional meeting scheduled during the week of October 24. All nominations must be submitted to the steering committee by October 14, 2011. Members of the steering committee will report the contact information for their representatives to each of the Regional Advisory Committees to Robin Barbour at [robin.barbour@dese.mo.gov](mailto:robin.barbour@dese.mo.gov) by no later than October 14, 2011.

Where: advisory committee meetings will be held in five (5) regions of the state, Kansas City, Springfield, Moberly, Poplar Bluff, and St. Louis. Meetings will be held from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. Locations will be determined.

Timeline: October 2011

## **II. Indicator/Model Selection**

Purpose: The MSIP 5 is expected to include a combination of current and additional indicators; based on a review of positive features of the current system, the public input strategy, and research on school effectiveness and accountability, a revised system of indicators will be chosen, as well as models for combining them into various performance levels. Presentations, meeting material and written small group feedback will be posted on the Department's website at [www.dese.mo.gov/qs/MSIP5.html](http://www.dese.mo.gov/qs/MSIP5.html) .

Who: a diverse, well-informed smaller group (approximately 30) of school, district and community representatives nominated by education organizations, school districts, higher education institutions and others. Nominees should have experience and expertise that will equip them to make informed decisions about the technical aspects of scoring guide development. Nominees must be available to attend two meetings scheduled November 8 and November 15. All nominations must be submitted to the steering committee by October 31, 2011. Members of the steering committee will report the contact information for their representatives to each of the Regional Advisory Committees to Robin Barbour at [Robin.Barbour@dese.mo.gov](mailto:Robin.Barbour@dese.mo.gov) by no later than October 31, 2011.

Where: two (2) model selection committee meetings will be held in Jefferson City.

Timeline: October 2011 – November 2011

## **III. Determine Standard Setting Methodology**

Purpose: Performance levels for each indicator and overall system performance need to be determined based on statistical analyses and expert judgment; this step will determine the methodology to be used to set these levels for each selected indicator and for the system as a whole, both for state improvement and accountability purposes, and as a potential replacement for federal AYP determination. Presentations, meeting material and meeting minutes will be posted on the Department's website at [www.dese.mo.gov/qs/MSIP5.html](http://www.dese.mo.gov/qs/MSIP5.html) .

Who: a well-informed small group (approximately 10) of district and community representatives. Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) members must have experience and expertise that will equip them to make informed decisions about the technical aspects of scoring guide development. Technical Advisory Committee members must be available to attend three meetings scheduled November 29, December 15, and December 16. TAC members will be identified by November 18, 2011.

Where: three (3) technical committee meetings will be held in Jefferson City.

Timeline: November 2011 – December 2011
