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1. Nonpublic (NCLB, 1120)

- The LEA consults with the nonpublic in assessing and evaluating their Title I services annually. During this consultation, the LEA and private school officials determine the standards that are to be used to measure the effectiveness of the Title I program, what assessment will be used to measure the agreed upon standards and what constitutes annual progress for the Title I program.

- Appropriate representation of public and nonpublic school personnel (required)
- Review of student achievement data (required)
- Established baseline and target for measuring progress (required)
- Review of parents' evaluations (required)
- Review of program strengths and weaknesses (required)
