ORDER OF DISMISSAL WITH PREJUDICE

On June 29, 2005 the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) received Petitioner's Request for a Due Process Hearing. On July 14, 2005, an impartial due process hearing officer was empowered to hear the request. Attorney Stephen Walker represents petitioners. Attorney Margaret Mooney represents Respondent School District. A hearing was commenced and in January 2006 the parties advised the Panel that settlement had been reached. The hearing was stayed to provide the parties adequate time to prepare the necessary paperwork. On or about February 25, 2006, Petitioners' attorney informed the Panel that the settlement was complete and requested that the Request be dismissed.

ACCORDINGLY, Petitioner's Request for Due Process Hearing is **DISMISSED** with prejudice.
