ORDER

Chair, by an Order dated February 25, 2006, granted Respondent's Motion for More Definite Statement. The Chair noted that the Petitioner had failed to identify the necessary elements to state a complaint. The Chair advised the Petitioner that the petition would be dismissed if not revised, meeting the statutory and regulatory requirements for such petitions. Petitioner was ordered to do so by March 13, 2006. The Petitioner has failed to do so, and Chair has been informed by the Respondent that mediation was undertaken by the Respondent District and the Petitioner which did not involve the Chair and the panel. The Chair has not been informed whether or not the mediation successfully involved the issues between the parties.

WHEREFORE, the case is dismissed for failure to state a claim under 20 U.S.C. Section 1415(b)(6).
