Section 4: Evaluation Tool

The Developmental Assessment of Young Children – 2nd Edition (DAYC-2) is a norm-referenced evaluation tool which utilizes professional observation and caregiver report. DAYC-2 consists of five subtests which measure developmental abilities in the following areas: cognition, communication, social-emotional development, physical development, and adaptive (self-help) skills. The DAYC-2 is not an IQ test and should not be used to predict future cognitive or developmental abilities.
