Love this program! It has helped our son progress so much and has helped me and my husband grow as parents!

We love our service provider. She does a great job with our son.

I have had a good experience this time. My first time with First Steps was a horrible experience. Much much better! And I am happy with results.

We are moving to another state. Therefore, will not be able to participate in parental programs.

Our First Steps team is so valuable! We really appreciate ALL they do for us!

Our PT person is the last to suggest any new equipment or tell me something is too small. I always find out from her day care teacher. I think it should be said to me so we can figure out if that is something she still needs and we need to get bigger or something different. I don't know, like the therapist, when something doesn't fit/work for her like it should.

I'm very fortunate for the help and support your program gives to families.

Our therapist was essential to our son's language development needs. She involved my husband and I, teaching us skills as well to improve our communication with our son. She was always kind, patient and punctual. We are very appreciative of First Steps and highly recommend the program!

Our therapists have been amazing to work with!

I absolutely LOVE this program. Our therapists have helped me out more than anyone ever could. At first, I thought my son's sudden stoppage in speech and communication was something we had done wrong. After expressing this concern, they both explained this has been happening more and more often than not, which took a huge burden off mine and my husbands shoulders knowing it wasn't our fault. I recommend PAT and First Steps to all women I know that have children or/and are pregnant. Both programs are amazing!

My First Steps team has been a great part of ensuring that my child learns more skills. I would have liked to increase his time more since he is a child who is severely delayed in communicating. I do however understand that we cannot have everything we want. But I was not informed that ABA therapy could be provided by First Steps until 11 months into the program. Even now, therapy has only increased to two hours per week, when I believe my child would benefit from more intensive therapy.

It was disappointing to find out how hard it is to get a child qualified for services in Missouri, especially compared to other states. My child was getting speech therapy twice a week at a pediatric speech facility and still wasn't originally approved for speech services with First Steps.

The reason I only answered "agree" and not "strongly agree" on questions #9 & 11 is because I feel First Steps therapists really more just reinforce what I am already doing with my child. But I need that reinforcement and encouragement too. I have NO complaints about my therapists or service coordinator, who have all been a great asset and support system/means to get me/us connected or access to equipment which I otherwise without First Steps would not have. It did take a long time to get "AT" (6 months) but we have them now and doing fine. My therapist brings equipment with her, which I believe is personally owned, so I feel very lucky to have access to that. I have seen a big improvement with my son the more we work with him.

I have had a huge issue with the administrative staff and was going to cancel First Steps because of it, but our service coordinator and therapists are so great and encouraging, they counselled us through the adversity, giving us proper contacts so we could make our complaint. (We have not made a formal complaint yet as we wanted it to be a logical move not an emotional reaction.) We stayed because of the service coordinator and therapists' support.

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When we moved back to MO my son was 15 months old. We were so stressed about getting his therapies switched over and concerned about him falling even further behind than he already was. Getting First Steps set up and therapies started was the easiest thing ever and so quick! Every person we have worked with through First Steps have been a major blessing to our family. Our son has flourished with their care and guidance. You can tell that each therapist as well as his case manager has taken a personal interest in his growth and development. I could not thank his therapists enough for all they do. They have not only taught him new skills but also taught my husband and I how to work with him when they are not here. Thank you all so much! You have bettered all our lives more than you may ever know.

Our primary provider was very knowledgeable and helpful about our son. However, scheduling with her was difficult at times. Sometimes she did not show up to scheduled appointments or she was 20-30 minutes late often.

The only thing that is hard is that our daughter was not part of a regular schedule. The First Steps coordinators do not keep in touch with me.

We are incredibly thankful for MO First Steps! We've seen a huge growth in our child and feel that our therapist is now like family.

Our therapist is AMAZING!

The providers play with my child, but don't include me in the playtime. They just work with my child one-on-one when I would prefer they teach me what to do with her.

First Steps is a great program. The providers are awesome, especially the home visitors. My son has gained so much with their help. My service coordinator is great. The nicest person ever!

We absolutely love our daughter's PT. She helps us with therapy and much more. I have never had any problems. If we have any questions beyond PT, she will find out the answer.

You guys are awesome!

The ladies at First Steps have been wonderful to work with. My foster daughter wouldn't speak, except to whisper "yeah" once in a while. She had an unhealthy obsession with food and would eat until she vomited. She wouldn't allow me to put her down without having an emotional breakdown. When she was angry she'd throw herself on the floor, kick, scream and bang her head. Now she's speaking in two-three word sentences, says "please", "thank you" and "welcome". She allows me to take her plate without getting upset when she's done eating (but there's still food on the plate)! She uses a spoon/fork, plays independently and with other children, and lets me leave the room without becoming emotionally distraught. She's learning colors and shapes and potty training. She does still throw tantrums but not to the magnitude that it used to be. She still has improvements she could do but we've come a long way in a very short time. Thank you!

Our primary developmental therapist has been wonderful to work with the past 3 years. Our speech therapist has been great, too.

Speech was our primary concern, and although we haven't seen a lot of progress there, he has had huge improvements behavior wise. And overall communications have improved as well.

We love, love, love our therapist. Thank you for putting her on my son's case. She's always pushing our son to do his best! Our service coordinator is wonderful. Very sweet and always on top of things. Thank you!

Referred by our PT. VERY helpful. Much easier for me and my family to have PT in the comfort of our own home. My daughter also responds to PT better here than at the University PT office. We are all more comfortable at home. Thank you!

Our family LOVES First Steps! We are so grateful for the services we receive and have seen a HUGE improvement in his development because of them. We love our providers and think of them as family.

Thank you for all your program does and offer for my child. Therapy through this program helps us so much more than if we had to do outpatient. Leaving work and coordinating is difficult even with two parents. So it is wonderful that therapy comes to our home. We are also guaranteed the same therapist, which is so important. Consistency is key. Again, we are forever grateful.

You guys were/are great. Helped relieve a lot of my fears/anxieties about if my daughter was on track for her adjusted age. Thanks for everything!

We do not feel that our child is getting all the services he should due to the teaming model. We feel it would be a better use of time and resources to sent in the appropriate therapists instead of only the primary provider. As our child has grown, it does not make sense to keep the same primary provider because his needs are not the same.

Our therapists have been great but we feel the teaming approach has limited their ability to work effectively with our child to meet his needs and our family's needs.

Thank you all for all you do to help families like mine! Every little bit helps and you help more than a little. :)

Our service coordinator has not been the most responsive or supportive of increasing our services. She went through things too fast and hasn't felt like her priority.

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My child has 3 different providers. One was once a week, one was every two weeks and one was once a month. I did not like that they would almost always come at the same time. So one hour of therapy included ALL services. I didn't feel my child was able to fully receive services at times because it was lumped together. Other than that, the providers are great and have helped us a lot. Thank you.

Our OT for my son often gave opinions that did not pertain to her area of focus. She was very open about her dislike for different medical professionals which seemed very unprofessional. I often felt pressured to avoid different foods that she did not prefer for my son. Again, these are not in her category of therapy and I feel she had no reason to be going over them.

My ABA team members are miracle workers! While my daughters problem is speech related, we finally received a diagnosis of Childhood Apraxia (9 months after starting services). We had testing for everything from Autism to Hearing and never had true answers. What was great about my First Steps team was they didn't care about a diagnosis; they cared about helping my child. They put a plan into action that would address her needs, and help our family. Her behavioral challenges were the starting point because while she couldn't talk, she could understand and that frustration of no communication tools turned into hourly struggles. They gave us the tools, some simple, some common-sense, that as an educator I know, but somehow forgot with my own child. Other techniques such as a pecs book required more work but have been wonderful. Our ABA team has taken the information from our speech and OT therapists and incorporated into their sessions and her progress is amazing. I don't know what I would do without them!

We had our first speech therapist for many months. She was fantastic. She took a general interest in my family and helped advise me with both my kids. She encouraged us to try new things and motivated us. We now have a new speech therapist and she is amazing. She's so personal and wants to know how she can help my child in every way. My son and I look forward to her coming every week. She's so detailed and encouraging.

You cannot imagine the relief that came with the support from First Steps. Everyone associated with the organization was truly dedicated to helping my daughter and our family. The financial burden without First Steps would have been catastrophic for my family. For this I will be forever grateful!

My only wish for First Steps is that my child's information, growth, notes, goals, achievements, concerns, are available in an online database of some sort. Her therapists take notes almost every session and I would like to see them when I want to.

When therapist comes for a session with my child as a whole, instead of teaching my child, they talk, look at their cell phones, or get to house late and not give their full time. Wish they were more committed when they work as a group, primary and other.

I don't need anyone to contact me, I am simply stating yes the above questions because I am willing to help First Steps in anyway that you guys need me to because I have been very pleased with the service.

My only complaint was that billing was contracted out and thus seemed not up-to-date. If a payment is made over the phone with the billing contractor, the payment should then be reflected immediately, instead of "up to 2 billing cycles." That just doesn't make sense.

It is frustrating that First Steps ends at 3yrs and kindergarten does not start till 6. My district Rockwood does offer continuation of some services but food sensory issues are not services that are provided. I am concerned that my child will refuse to eat once school starts.

My provider seems to get discouraged at times when my child is less than cooperative. At age 2, it is normal for this to happen occasionally. I feel that my provider could improve the services by having some better strategies for keeping a 2-year-old engaged.

I am very grateful and thankful for First Steps. I feel lucky to be a Missouri resident just because of the services First Steps provides. I would like their website to be more updated and modern and user friendly.

We want to start by saying First Steps is a great program that has made a noticeable, positive impact on our daughter and our family.

Our first PT didn't have the experience with infants we were expecting, but this was quickly remedied. The transition to a new therapist was seamless, and she is an amazing PT. We feel very fortunate to have her helping our daughter. The same is true for our SLP. She is very patient and knowledgeable in her field. She helps us to help our daughter with daily activities and ways to improve her developmental skills.

We recently had a transition to a different OT, which was a little disappointing. We feel the transition lacked communication and could have been handled better. We had developed a great relationship with our OT. He is great and did a fantastic job working with our daughter. With no prior discussion, we were told we had a new OT via text message from our service coordinator. While we understand sometimes scheduling conflicts and client load may affect a therapist's availability, we would have preferred to have the transition discussed with us prior to any final decisions being made. While working with therapists, it is sometimes hard to establish the right bond between the therapist and the child...as was the case with our first PT. We really enjoyed working with him and we will miss him.

Overall, we have been very happy with First Steps. We appreciate everything that everyone in the First Steps organization has done for us, and look forward to working with the First Steps team in the future.

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We discovered First Steps by luck. Would it be possible to include First Steps information (maybe a pamphlet) with the newborn paperwork the hospital sends home?

The therapists that worked with our daughter were knowledgeable. However, because they saw her in a day care setting we had very little contact. Even after I specifically asked that they keep us aware of activities so that we could implement them at home, they failed to do so on a regular basis. It is my understanding that they may have too many children on their caseloads, so I can understand, but even so it was very disappointing. We spent most of our time doing research on our own and buying/reading books on the subject to help us help our daughter.

My son's provider with First Steps is absolutely amazing. Not only does she help teach my son the tools/skills he needs, she teaches me how to best aid him with mastering those. I am a nurse so sometimes I tend to be a little more critical of any type of provider. She has time and time again met and exceeded my expectations. If I have a question/concern/problem solving question, she makes time in her day to call me to discuss. She engages with my son's preschool teachers to make sure he is getting any extra help there that he may need. We are fortunate that our obstacle has really only been speech. Not only did I experience having difficulty actually seeing the SLP assigned to my child, I have heard the same thing from other families I know who are enrolled in First Steps. It seems like there isn't a reliable SLP with feeding experience that is available.

Would like to know why our child can't stay with First Steps until he starts school. We have a close relationship with our therapist and don't want to go through school and have to start over. Thank you

She has wonderful communication skills, ALWAYS on time and always had a plan for that day. Our daughter couldn't move when we first got her at 6 months old through foster care. Through your program and therapists she is RUNNING, turning her head, eating without throwing up, not falling down as much, and just able to do anything now! Thank you SO MUCH!

Since this is my 3rd child to receive services, I will continue to praise this program and everyone involved in my children's plan. This has been a must need service for them. What I am most displeased with is the intake process. Each of my three children had to be screened 2 x's in order to pass to receive services when it was VERY obvious at the time of the first test they were delayed and needed it. When an 18 month old is not talking at all there is an obvious issue. It was very disheartening each time of the first test to hear they did not qualify only to be retested 90 days later and finally qualify. By doing this you are only delaying the care issue for the child's needs. I wish this would change. Other than that, First Steps has been wonderful to work with and we always have liked our therapists.

I am very disappointed in the services we have received from First Steps from day 1. We do not have a provider seeing our child that is knowledgeable about our child's disability. We have requested other therapists and never been given a correct provider. We have had 3 different service coordinators in less than 18 months. The service coordinator we currently have does not respond to texts or phone calls for several days. Asks what day work for us for appointments. We give her a day and then she tells us that doesn't work after several days. We have offered for her to give us a couple days to choose from that work for her and she continually cancels or says she's unavailable. I have spoken with her supervisor about these issues and still do not have resolve. Very disappointed in FS and would recommend to NO ONE unless very last resort for services.

Such an important program- we've been happy with our experience through the First Steps program.

I like the new option to bill insurance and waive the monthly fees. For a time, it was somewhat cost prohibitive to participate with limited visits from the primary provider.

I am still waiting for my occupational therapist to email me pointers and tips with toddler sensory activities. It's been over 2 months and I have reached out but, still waiting.

Our SLP is the BEST! I couldn't have asked for anyone better to be helping and improving my daughter's speech. She is a BLESSING!

We have had an amazing experience with First Steps. Our therapists have been amazing. Everyone is helpful, professional, on time, aware, exceptional all around. I cannot say enough good things!

I have actually had two different speech therapists for my daughter as one of them changed districts. The first one was amazing on getting us on the right foot.
