

System Enhancements		
IFSP – Getting to Know Our Family	Impacted Users: SPOE	MWS-9901
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The “Getting to Know Our Family” section of the IFSP will be removed beginning with meeting dates on 9/30/2020. For meeting dates prior to 9/30/2020, the “Getting to Know Our Family” section will remain. Historical IFSP’s will continue to display this section. 		
IFSP – Family Assessment	Impacted Users: SPOE	MWS-9901
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Family Assessment section of the IFSP will be modified to display a new statement. The new statement will read, “The family chooses to include information from the family assessment in the IFSP.” The current “What resources does the family use?” textbox will be modified to display “What are the family’s supports and resources?”. This question will also be the first question listed in the Family Assessment section. The “What are the family’s concerns?” textbox will be moved and will be the second question displayed. The “Of the concerns, what would the family like to focus on (priorities)?” textbox will be moved and will be the third question displayed.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> New options will be added to the “Routines” drop down menu. The added options are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Meal Preparation Time Outdoors Hanging Out Time Child Care Other Family Routine 		

- The Child Outcomes page will be modified to include a new Routines field. The Routine selected must be a Routine identified on the “Routines & Activities” page.
 - Please note that all active Child Outcomes carried forward from prior IFSP Meetings will need to be updated to identify a routine.
- The Child Outcome Statement will be modified:
 - The “Participate in Routine” prompt within the “Child will” textbox will be modified to “Action And Specific Behaviors”
 - The “Action and Specific Behaviors” prompt within the “By” textbox will be modified to “What Will The Outcome Look Like When It Is Met.”
 - The “We will know Child can do this when” text box will be hidden.
- The Evaluation of Progress section will be modified:
 - A new field will be added “The Team knows this outcome is met when <Child> completes the task”. This field will require the user to select 1 of the following options:
 - When Prompted
 - Each Time Attempted
 - Daily
 - A Few Times Per Week
 - Once Weekly
 - Monthly
 - The “How the Team will measure progress” field shall be modified to display “The Team plans to measure progress through”
 - The “When the Team will measure progress” field shall be hidden
- The Child Outcome changes will take effect for meeting dates on or after 9/30/2020. Meetings prior to 9/30/2020 will maintain the current Child Outcome fields to preserve the child’s IFSP history.
