Types of Incentive	Classroom Bucks (each class has own color)	Gold Bucks	100 Paw Prints
How Students Earn	<p>Total of 3 per day</p> <p>1 Buck for attendance</p> <p>1 Buck for bringing backpack</p> <p>1 Buck for bringing notebook</p>	<p>Should only be earned when the student is actually demonstrating appropriate social skills. Should be given to the student directly or handed to a staff with the student. Student must be told what social skill they performed and why they are receiving a gold buck.</p> <p>Staff is provided 20 gold bucks per week to distribute.</p> <p>Staff names are on these bucks.</p>	<p>Students earn 1 paw print for every 25 bucks spent in the store. Paw prints are put on the "100 Paw Wall". Celebrations are held when 100 paws are earned.</p> <p>Students and staff choose the celebration activity from two activities selected by the Student Activities Committee.</p>
How students spend bucks		<p>Students can go to the store at any time, accompanied by staff. Spent bucks should be left in the store in the designated box and staff should record on the tally sheet located in the store the student's name and # of bucks spent. A designated staff member (Rose) will pick up the bucks, compare them with the tally sheet and post paws on the "100 Paw Wall" accordingly.</p>
