# Upcoming Projects


- Upcoming projects based on a Capacity Building Institute for Transition include:
  - Increase the number of districts who receive Transition Outcomes Training (TOP)
  - To make certain IEP teams consider independent living as a necessity which should be addressed for all students
  - To increase the number of measurable goals in the area of independent living in student IEPs.

# Upcoming Projects

- Create a transition guide/fact sheet which highlights transition assessments and how they assist in with writing measurable post-secondary goals.
- Develop a cross-agency training for authentic, customized work based learning for students and adults with disabilities. This group will work toward creating guidance documents regarding Work Based Learning.

- Develop short topical brief about the transition process that are parent friendly.
- Develop a simple transition guide with three action targets:
  - teachers
  - parents
  - students

# The Career Competencies

- ❑ Developed by The Research Collaboration at the University of Kansas
- ❑ Identified 29 competencies supported by research as essential for career readiness
- ❑ These competencies are across three domains
  - ❑ Interpersonal
  - ❑ Intrapersonal
  - ❑ Cognitive




# Training and Materials

- Currently materials have been developed for six of the competencies
- These materials are available online
- Materials provided to teams includes a video detailing the characteristics of the competency, a teacher guide with activities that can be utilized, and the research upon which it is based.
- It also provides a poster
- A survey to be completed by the student, teacher and the parent
