What is B.E.S.T.?

- B.E.S.T. (Basic Employment Skills Training) is
 - A work based internship program for high school seniors identified with developmental disabilities
 - Housed in a business environment
 - Provides real life opportunities to gain transferable skills related to employment

History of Program

- 15-16 school year
 - Career Exploration Program was launched
 - Scott Spear (Transition Liaison)
 - Learned about the S.T.E.P. program
 - Columbia Public Schools & Boone Hospital
 - Mr. Sampson reached out to Hannibal Regional Hospital
- 16-17 school year
 - Team from Hannibal Public Schools & Hannibal Regional Hospital visited the S.T.E.P. program
 - This visit began the partnership and development the B.E.S.T. program

History of Program Continued

- 17-18 School Year
 - Brock Sousa (Transition Liaison)
 - Identified 7 students as possible candidates
 - Narrowed down to 5
 - All 5 students had an 3 yr. Re-Eval
 - Collaboration with several outside agencies
 - Marion County Services, County Connections, Learning Opportunities, GAMM Incorporated & Vocational Rehab.
 - All students in program will receive services from at least 1 agency if not all agencies.
 - May 2018 5 students interviewed and toured Hospital
 - June 2018 during summer school 3 students participated in a paid work internship

What's Happening this Year

- 18-19 School Year
 - First year of B.E.S.T. program
 - 4 students will be participating
 - 1 student in Foods
 - 2 students in Environmental Services
 - 1 Student in Materials
 - Paid internship
 - Upto 240 hrs or 6 months
 - Additional grant for 240 hrs
 - First 2 weeks of school
 - Background checks
 - Shots and Records
 - Opened/Trained Career II Students
 - Coffee Shop, Custodial, Car Wash
 - Students were outfitted with 3 pairs of work clothes and shoes.

First year cont.


- All students will have a job coach




