RTN's assist youth with disabilities, and their families, with the post-secondary transition process



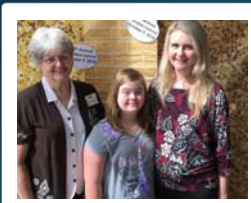

Youth Trainings



MPACT provides training specific to transition age youth and their families. In 2018 there were . . .

- 26 Youth Transition Trainings reaching nearly 1,000 youth
- 500 youth who attended Regional Transition Network events
- 238 individuals who attended statewide summit
- 150 youth who attended St. Louis City Summit

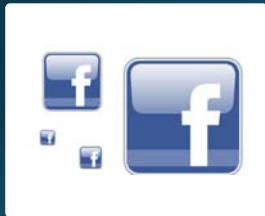
Transition Mentors

MPACT has a volunteer mentor program. As part of this program, we have specialized Transition Mentors

- 11 Transition Mentors
- Transition Mentors receive specialized transition training and certification
- Transition Mentors attend Expos/Fairs
- Transition Mentors provide One to One assistance with youth and families
- Over 60,000 Transition related material distributed via email, newsletter and in person.
