What Does a CTEInstructor Look Like?

- At least two years of full-time work experience in their area of instruction
- Educational background will vary
- Complete an abridged and accelerated teacher certification process
- May be expected to maintain industry specific credentials beyond teacher certification

What is Hybrid CTE?

- Hybrid Programs are designed to accommodate a diverse group of learners
- Instruction is differentiated to emphasize the strengths of each student
- Ideal for students seeking to explore specific career pathways in a smaller setting with additional supports that facilitate learning

What is Hybrid CTE?

 Programs segway into multiple CTE Pathways including CTE at Tech, Other Hybrid at Tech, Vocational Skills Program (VSP), Job Corps, 2-year college and/or Employment

Typical students are considering competitive employment
 OR post-secondary education (typically 2-year or short term training)

What do Hybrid Programs Offer?

- Career & Technical Exploration
- Field Experiences
- Business Partnerships
- WorkKeysTesting
- Relevant Curriculum
 - Employability Skills (Face to Face)
 - Life Skills
 - Career & Technical Training



This opportunity is for students* who meet these criteria:



- On-Track for On-Time
 Graduation
- Graduating based on credits
- Positive attendance
- Positive discipline record
- Safe and some independent work skills

*May have full SPED minutes

Important Considerations

- Hybrid sections are capped at 10 students or fewer
- Lead Teacher is a CTE
 Certified Teacher without
 Special Education
 Certification
- Students may be required to take a TSA or IRC exam

- Active additional resources for teaching staff & students
 - Social Emotional Behavior Support
 - SPED Teacher
 - Possible TA Support
 - Adaptive Assignments
 - Modified Tests
 - IEP Supports

How does this work with DESE?

- DESE Course Name: Career Education Preparation
- DESE Course Code: 996300
- Certification Required: Industrial Arts, Vocational Prepor any Career Education certificate.
- These courses are considered exploratory and are not subject to Perkins requirements such as assessment or placement.

Fast Facts - Students with IEPs at North & South Tech

- 2017-18 School Year
 - 377 students enrolled at North or South Tech had an active IEP
 - 214 students at South Tech
 - 163 students at North Tech
- 2018-19 School Year
 - Data remains similar to previous years.



Fast Facts - Placement

- 2016-17 School Year
 - 59.7% College or Post-Secondary
 - 4-Year 34.3%
 - 2-Year 54.4%
 - Other 11.3%
 - o 29.5% Employed
 - o 3.2% Military



Fast Facts - Hybrid Application Process



- Mirrors the Traditional
 Application Process
- Increased dialogue with Case Manager
- Holistic approach considers student's background and career goals
- CTE applicant can be referred to hybrid program at any point
