

FEDERAL SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT GRANT (SIG), TITLE I, SECTION 1003(G) OF ESEA

AWARD: In no instance will an award exceed \$2,000,000 or be less than \$50,000. Grant activities will begin July 1, 2014. All grant activities for Cadre II year three and Cadre III year two must end as of June 30, 2015.

DEADLINE: All applications must be delivered to the Federal Grants and Resources Unit of the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education by noon on Friday, June 13, 2014, or must be postmarked on Friday, June 13, 2014. Faxed applications will not be accepted.

REQUIREMENT: To be considered, the Department must receive an original and two copies of the entire renewal application package. The applicant will also submit an electronic copy of the renewal application package (including attachments) to webrepliesiggrants@dese.mo.gov by 11:59 p.m. Friday, June 13, 2014.

An acceptable application must be submitted in the order listed in the application form. The narrative sections of the proposal must be double-spaced and the font used must not be smaller than 10-point.
