Dual Credit – Dual Enrollment

- Q. We have what we have always referred to as Dual Credit, but should it be Dual Enrollment?
- A. If the course is taught by a district instructor, earning both high school and college credit , report DIST. If the course is taught by a college instructor, earning both high school and college credit, report COLL.

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Virtual Scenario

- Q. We have a student taking an online class, on their own time, can we report this as virtual?
- A. The course must meet the requirements of 162.1250 RSMo. You will report the EDSSN of the virtual educator, and a Course Delivery System of V.

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Electronic Media Scenario

Q. How do we report an online course with a supervising teacher?

A. In the past, guidance was to report study hall for the supervising educator, then report another record for the course itself. After further discussion, our guidance is to report one record with the course number and the supervising educator, with course delivery system S. If college instructor, report COLL for the dual credit site on the Student Assignment file.

If more than one course is supervised, report as combined courses and divide the minutes.

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College Course Scenario

Q. Our students go to a local college for courses, how should we report them, and is this dual enrollment?

A. Report the course, no EDSSN of the college instructor; since it is a college instructor and if the student is receiving college credit, report Dual Credit Site of COLL.

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ITV Scenario

Q. Our district has multiple teachers supervising the ITV room, in the past I have not reported an EDSSN with the class. Do I need to report an EDSSN for ITV classes?

A: The district providing the ITV instruction reports the educator, course and students.
