ADDITIONAL DATES/RESOURCES

- Currently the ability to review corrections to prior year 2013-14 data can be accessed securely via the MCDS Portal – Guided Inquiry, MSIP5 Annual Performance Report (APR), Supporting Detail Reports.
- The week of May 11, 2015: the 2014-15 data (numerator, denominator and rates) will be posted for parts of Standard 3, and all of Standards 4 and 5. This information will be available as districts certify the June MOSIS cycle of data.
- June 22 – July 1, 2015: the June ID clean-up process will be available for certification.
- July 27 – 31, 2015: the MOSIS ID clean-up process will be available for the third party College and Career Ready measures.

Frequent Problems

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- Standard 1 and 2 – Level Not Determined Exceeds 5%
 - Graduates required to take 4 End-Of-Course (EOC) assessments (Algebra I, English II, Biology I, American Government)
 - Resources
 - MCDS Securely – EOC History Report
 - MOSIS February Student Core – list of 12th grade students without an EOC
 - MOSIS EOC Submission
- Standard 1 and 2 – Student Demographics
 - April Student Core – source for student demographic information.
 - Reminders
 - Review Full Academic Year
 - IEP Status



Frequent Problems

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- Standard 3*1-3 (ACT, COMPASS, SAT, ASVAB)
 - Last year concerns about COMPASS data.
 - Update
 - Receiving all Missouri Career Technical School Scores
 - CCR ID Clean-Up (potentially the week of July 20th)
 - Reminder
 - Districts must submit ASVAB scores
- Standard 3*4 (Test scores -- AP, IB, PLTW, Course Grades -- AP, IB, Dual Credit, Dual Enrollment, Certificate -- IRC)
 - IRC (Industry Recognized Credential)
 - Reminders
 - MOSIS June Student Core submission – separate field for IRC, system does not use TSA field for the MSIP APR.
 - Summer School Dual Credit can be submitted in the June Course Completion trial. **Note summer school in June/July 2014 would be reported in the 2015 June Course Completion.**



Frequent Problems

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- Standard 3*5-6 (180 Day Follow-Up Data)
 - Make sure to submit February Graduate Follow-Up
- Standard 3*HRS
 - Make sure to submit 8th grade students as Remained Advancing, in the June MOSIS SEA file.
- Standard 4 Attendance Rate
 - Make sure to submit Screen 10 in Core Data – Actual Calendar
- Standard 5 Graduation Rate
 - Resources
 - MOSIS – June State Level Violations
 - Guided Inquiry, District and School Information, District and Building Graduation Indicators – *“Student Cohort Report Unofficial”*




Frequent Problems
