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## Required End-of-Course Assessments (class of 2014)

Administrative Memo – EOC Accountability and testing requirements
- Districts will receive a Level Not Determined (LND) for each student who graduates without participating in the MAP EOC or without provided evidence of prior accountability fulfillment at the high school level in each required EOC assessment (**Algebra I, English II, Biology and Government**).
- The Department will review all students reported as 2014 graduates by your district to ensure that each graduate participated in each of the four assessments. If a student graduates without participating or without evidence of prior accountability, the student will be added to the district's accountable number and the district will receive a LND for that student in that content area.



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## EOC History Report by Student

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- **An EOC History Report, by student, is available via the MCDS Portal.**
- Logon to the secure-side of the MCDS Portal
  - Put your cursor over Guided Inquiry
    - From the drop down select State Assessment
      - Under the Administrative heading
        - Choose EOC History Report
- Must have the following access:
  - MAP Results Student Level



## EOC History Report by Student (cont.)

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- The report shows all EOC assessments taken by a student.
- The student will be provided in the report, if the student was marked as enrolled on the count date in the MOSIS 2014 October or February Student Core Files. NOTE: The report will be refreshed upon recertification of MOSIS files.
- The data download file (available in Quick Links > State Assessment) contains a tab delimited file of all students that can be downloaded and merged into local systems for analysis.



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## Reporting EOC Exceptions

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**If a student has not participated, districts have three options.**

- 1) You may enroll the student in the spring administration of the assessment.
- 2) You may report to the department those students who had prior accountability fulfillment through the EOC Exception Collection.
- 3) You may not respond and accept the Level Not Determined (LND) for the student. (Reminder: No points are awarded if the LND is greater than or equal to 5%.)



## Reporting EOC Exceptions (cont.)

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### □ **MOSIS Collection – “EOC Exception”**

- File Layout and excel template posted at <http://dese.mo.gov/MOSIS/FileLayout.html>
- Used the existing EOC Precode File Layout – (not all fields are required) and modified the ASSESSMENT field to capture the following reasons:

EOC Exception 1 **EOCEX1** EOC Not Operational  
EOC Exception 2 **EOCEX2** Out-of-State or Non-Public  
EOC Exception 3 **EOCEX3** MAP Alternate  
EOC Exception 4 **EOCEX4** Took content at other Public



## Reporting EOC Exceptions (cont.)

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- **MOSIS Collection – “EOC Exception”**
  - EOC Exception “download” report.
    - A report has been added to the MOSIS **FEBRUARY** Student Core cycle. (February 2014 Student Core EOCEXceptionList report (MS Excel) )
    - This report allows a district to download students reported as a 12<sup>th</sup> grader (and enrolled in the district on the last Wednesday in January) that do not have an EOC assessment record. This report will be pre-formatted for the EOC Exception file layout.
    - The district will need to modify this report before submitting it to the Department – students may need to be removed (took the assessment during the spring administration) added to the file (not enrolled at the time the report was generated) AND the exception reason will need to be added for all students left in the report.



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## Processing the records for accountability

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### Processing the records the Department will:

- Identify graduates for 2013-14 (MOSIS June Student Enrollment and Attendance file)
- Review the EOC Assessments taken by those graduates (A1, E2, B1, GV)
- If the student does not have an EOC record, then will review the EOC Exceptions data
- If the student does not have an EOC assessment record or EOC Exception documentation -- an assessment record will be added for that subject area as a "non participant" or LND.
- Appeals process
