Q: In all the changes with the MOSIS/Core Data manual, do we need to make any adjustments for this year with the new grade level 18?

A: Grade 18 is used for early childhood assignments (grades PK through grade 3) but not for single grade classes (Grade 01 for example). Few changes would be needed.

Q: Where did you say to look for the NSC report?

A: The NCS report is under secured access, Guided Inquiry, District and School Information, District and Building Graduation and Dropout Indicators

Q: I haven't seen the pdf on the June Referral but are there definitions to what each category means?

A: Check out the links for the Referral collection (MOSIS web page). There are definitions and Q&A.

Q: How do snow days impact the 21 day stop out rule?

A: The 21 days includes all calendar days including weekends and snow days.

Q: Are there any plans to open up the June E&A and SC collection early for a trial like last year?

A: June cycle is open now, but cannot be certified.

Q: I have a Parent Educator that is .5 FTE classroom aide. I am getting an error on her highest degree of education if I list it one way and error on the other job description if I list it the other way. How do I clear that up?
