## Reminders – End-of-Course (EOC) Exceptions

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- **March EOC Exceptions**
- Use the February Cycle – Student Core Submission
- Reports
  - February 2014 Student Core EOCEXceptionList report (MS Excel)  
  
Provides a list of students (12<sup>th</sup> graders) that have not taken one of the required EOC exams (Algebra I, English II, Biology, American Government).  
  
The report does NOT include any assessments the student would have taken during the 2013-14 school year.



## Reminders – End-of-Course (EOC) Exceptions

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### □ **March EOC Exceptions**

- Allows the district to report by student and EOC Assessment

Code	Description
EOCEX1	EOC Exception 1: Student received content prior to assessment becoming operational.
EOCEX2	EOC Exception 2: Student received content out-of-state; in a private, parochial or home school.
EOCEX3	EOC Exception 3: MAP-Alternate – Student received credit in other district, or content not applicable.
EOCEX4	EOC Exception 4: Student took content in another public Missouri district, but was not assessed. Note - For students who received content prior to assessment becoming operational use EOCEX1.

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- **National Student Clearinghouse (NSC)**  
**Data Refreshed 12/19/2013**  
Guided Inquiry -- District and School Information – District and Building Student Indicators – “Graduates found in Higher Ed (NSC)”
- List of Graduates who were found in a higher education institution matched with the National Student Clearinghouse (NSC).
- Reminder: New rules have been added to the MOSIS February Cycle – Graduate Follow-Up. The new rules will be using thresholds to help determine accuracy of reporting the follow-up data.





- Report will display the CCR Measures for all students in the district regardless of grade based on the students reported in the 2014 October Student Core.

## Reminders – Release Schedule

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- **Prior Year Data Finalized (2012-13 data)**
  - Prior year data changes complete by 5:00 pm June 27, 2014
- **June ID Clean-Up Process**
  - Anticipated to be available June 25, 2014 – July 11, 2014
- **MAP 2013-14 Data Securely Provided**
  - Anticipated to be available July 21, 2014
- **CCR ID Clean-Up Process**
  - Anticipating getting an initial ACT file the first part of July and having a “CCR ID” clean-up process available July 25, 2014

( LEA | School )

**Standard 3** -- CCR Indicator 5-6 - Postsecondary Follow-Up  
( LEA | School )

**Standard 3** (K-8) -- High School Readiness

**Standard 4** -- Proportional Attendance Rate  
( LEA | School )

**Standard 5** -- Graduation Rate (4, 5, & 6 year)  
( LEA | School )
