


- **June ID Clean-Up Process**
 - Anticipated to be available June 25, 2014 – July 11, 2014
- **MAP 2013-14 Data Securely Provided**
 - Anticipated to be available the last two weeks in July
- **CCR ID Clean-Up Process**
 - Anticipating getting an initial ACT file the first part of July and having a “CCR ID” clean-up process available July 25, 2014

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In preparation for the release of the 2014 Annual Performance Report (APR), the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (Department) has prepared the schedule for the data release and appeals process. Please note two important data management items:

1. The prior year data will be frozen as of June 27, 2014 (this includes data July 1, 2012 – June 30, 2013).
2. Second, the schedule includes an opportunity to make corrections to 2014 data and appeal test scores. This will allow districts an opportunity to review data before the release of the MSIP5 APR and will accommodate a narrower window of time between the secured release and final posting of the APR.
