SIS/RFP Background



Time Line

4

- Fall 2009
 - Districts contacted the Department inquiring about the possibility of a standard student information system.
- Spring 2010
 - State workgroup discussed what this would look like – monthly webinars March – May.
- Summer 2010
 - Vendor fair to review features and functions of various systems to help with the writing of the Request for Proposals (RFP)
- Fall 2010 – Spring 2011
 - Writing the RFP



Time Line

5

- April 2011
 - RFP released for competitive bidding.
- May 2011 – December 2011
 - Evaluation team reviewed the bids and made a recommendation.
- December 2011
 - Contract awarded

- The student information system is intended to assist districts in managing student data, planning for educational programs, and complying with state and federal reporting requirements. This system will support daily functions at the school/district level.
- This award follows an exhaustive, collaborative effort which began last spring. The RFP and bidding process was lead by the Missouri Office of Administration in conjunction with the Department and a diverse group of school district advisors.

Q: Are districts required to use this system?
A: No, districts are not required to use this system.

Q: Will the Department continue to work with other vendors?
A: Yes.

Q: Does this change MOSIS reporting requirements?
A: No, not at this point in time.



FAQ

Q: Can the district host the system?
A: Yes, either the district or Tyler can provide the hosting services.

Q: What are the plans for a State Advisory Group?
A: The contract requires Tyler to organize a statewide advisory group, that will meet four times a year at a site provided by the Department or a district. This will include a minimum of one DESE representative and a minimum of eight district representatives selected by DESE. This group will help to identify needs related to training, technical assistance and modifications needed for the student information system.
