

Missouri Young Farmers Summer Tour

July 30th – August 1st, 2015

Mexico, Missouri

Thursday, July 30th

- Registration opens 5pm Thursday night at Audrain County Fairgrounds.
- There will be pizza and card tables set up with cards for any who want to play, or just visit.
- There is a tractor display set up for the entire tour.

Friday, July 31st

- Fairgrounds: Friday morning breakfast at 7am (subject to change 30 minutes either way) then board buses for all day tours.
- Lunch at Sygen then afternoon tours.
- Return back at fairgrounds for Friday night supper
 - FFA issues team from Paris (Ag Drones)
 - Keynote speaker (Tony Robertson of Mexico)
 - Followed by a local band.

Saturday, August 1st

- Fairgrounds: Saturday morning breakfast at 7am (subject to change 30 minutes either way) board buses for tours.
- Buses return to fairgrounds for lunch and closing.
- After lunch will board buses for the optional Saturday afternoon tours which will return at approximately 4:30.

The only meal not at fairgrounds is Friday lunch

We will be using the Audrain County 4-H fair grounds as our base for this year's tour. It is located ½ mile west on (21509) HWY D just South of Mexico.

If you are coming from the East, West, or South take I-70 to Kingdom City then head north on HWY 54. Take the first Mexico exit and as soon as you get off the over pass there is a blacktop that heads to the West, this is HWY D or Vance Road. (the road is within about 20ft of the on ramp to get back on 54 and head South – If you reach the Wal-Mart or John Deere dealership driveways you have gone too far).

You will go down HWY D (Vance Road) about a mile, the fairgrounds are on the right side of the road just past the rail road tracks
