The Readers for the Blind (RFB) Program provides assistance to public school districts, including those in special school districts or those students attending Missouri colleges, universities, technical or professional schools, who are not clients of the Office of Adult Learning and Rehabilitation Services or Department of Social Services' Rehabilitation Services for the Blind (RSB).

**SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS**

Applications and supporting documentation for services provided to qualified students during the current school year must be submitted electronically by November 30 in the same school year to [spedfunding@dese.mo.gov](mailto:spedfunding@dese.mo.gov). Complete all applicable blue highlighted fields.

Supporting documentation: Electronic copies of current eye reports are required as supporting documentation for all new student applicants, as well as for students with eye reports older than three years on file with RSB. Paper copies of eye reports will not be accepted. Failure to submit supporting documentation for students listed in the "New or Updated Students" section of this application may result in a delay in processing your claim, or in a finding of ineligible for those students.
